CADE enters into six agreements in investigations into HR information exchange

The Brazilian Antitrust Authority (CADE) entered into six agreements (Settlement Agreements) in investigations into the exchange of competitively sensitive information between Human Resources departments, bringing in proceeds of R\$

115 million (approx. US\$ 20 million). The companies investigated are multinationals from different markets, including companies from the consumer and healthcare sectors.

On May 21, 2025, Provisional Presidential Decree No. 1,300 was published, which deals with the Reform of the Electric Power Sector, taking effective immediately, with 60 days for conversion into law.

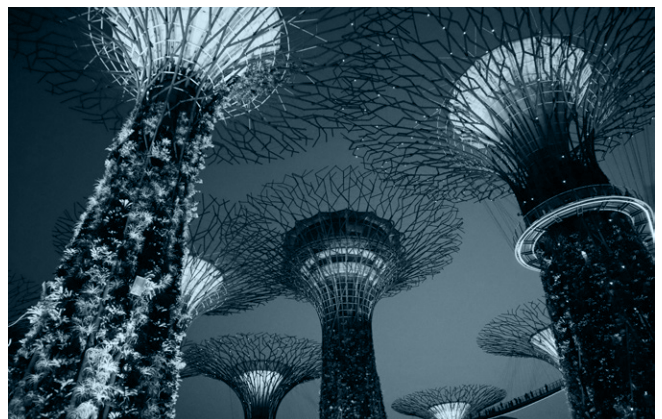
